## PAST SIMPLE – REGULAR AND IRREGULAR VERBS

**A** - THEY WATCH television every evening. – presente simple

THEY WATCH**ED** television yesterday evening – past simple

WATCH**ED** in the past simple:

I - WE - YOU - THEY - HE - SHE - IT = WATCH**ED**

**B** – The past simple is often – **ed** (regular verbs). For example:

work – work**ed**      clean – clean**ed**      dance – dance**ed**

enjoy- enjoy**ed**      This morning I clean**ed** my teeth.

Peter work**ed** in a bank from 2000 to 2020.

We enjoy**ed** the party last night. We dance**ed** a lot and talk**ed** to a lot of people.

**C**- Some verbs are irregular ( = not regular). The past simple is not –**ed**. Here are some importante irregular verbs:

| Break-broke    | Find – found    | Lose – lost  | Sit – sat       |

| Build – built  | Forget – forgot | Meet – Met   | Speak – spoke   |
| Buy – bought   | Get – got       | Pay – paid   | Stand – stood   |
| Catch – caught | Give – gave     | Put – put    | Take – took     |
| Come – came    | Go – went       | Read – read  | Tell – told     |
| Do – did       | Have – had      | Ring – rang  | Think – thought |
| Drink – drank  | Hear – heard    | Say – Said   | Win – won       |
| Eat – ate      | Know – Knew     | See – saw    | Write - wrote   |
