PAST SIMPLE – REGULAR AND IRREGULAR VERBS

A - THEY WATCH television every evening. – presente simple

THEY WATCH**ED** television yesterday evening – past simple

WATCH**ED** in the past simple:

I - WE - YOU - THEY - HE - SHE - IT = WATCH**ED**

B – The past simple is often – **ed** (regular verbs). For example:

work – work**ed** clean – clean**ed** dance – dance**ed**

enjoy- enjoy**ed** This morning I clean**ed** my teeth.

Peter work**ed** in a bank from 2000 to 2020.

We enjoy**ed** the party last night. We dance**ed** a lot and talk**ed** to a lot of people.
